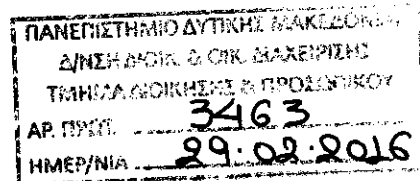

Foreign Applicants for Scholarship Stays in Slovakia

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
- related to a study stay (1 – 2 semesters) of foreign university students at a Slovak university during their Master studies
- related to a study/research stay (1 – 12 months) of PhD students from foreign universities/research organizations at a university or research organization eligible to carry out study programmes in Slovakia during their PhD studies
- related to a research stay (1 – 12 months) of university teachers/researchers, researchers of artistic origin (foreign university/research organization) and a university/research organization eligible to carry out study programmes in Slovakia

Citizens of which countries are eligible?

Citizens of the following countries can apply for the scholarship:

- 1) the Member States of the European Union
- 2) other countries can be added in the decision process listed are just:
 - USA, Canada, Mexico, Chile, Argentina, Australia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Iceland, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Russian Federation, Serbia (including Kosovo), Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Kyrgyzstan

What is the amount of a scholarship stay?

- 1) university students: 500 €
 - 2) PhD students: 650 €
 - 3) scientific degree holders: 850 €
 - 4) university teachers/researchers: 1 000 €
 - 5) artistic origin: 1 000 €
- with PhD degree and more than 10 years of work experience
 • with PhD degree and more than 10 years of work experience
 • with PhD degree and more than 10 years of work experience

Slovak Applicants for Scholarship Stays and Travel Grants Abroad

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
- related to a study stay abroad (1 – 2 semesters or 1 – 3 trimesters) of Slovak university students during their Master studies
- related to a study/research stay abroad (1 – 12 months) of PhD students from Slovak universities/research organizations eligible to carry out PhD study programmes at the Slovak Academy of Sciences during their PhD studies

- **travel grants** – cost of travel expenses related to Slovak research stays abroad of students of Slovak universities during their Master studies, university PhD students of Slovak universities during their PhD studies and university teachers/researchers of Slovak universities and the Slovak Academy of Sciences

Which country can you choose for your scholarship stay?

The Programme covers stays in any country, unless after being awarded a scholarship you can carry out your scholarship stay in any of the following countries:

What is the amount of a scholarship?

The amount of a scholarship is set for every country individually. It shall never exceed 15 000 euros during scholarship stay. When carrying the amount of a scholarship, cash living costs are taken into consideration. These are not covered other costs, e.g. housing fee.
